Dear SST Customer,

As part of SST's continuing effort to ensure reliable delivery of our high quality SuperFlash® technology products, we are beginning production of two new lines of SST25VF016B at our partner facility, Powerchip. SST25VF016B, revisions B and revision C, are being released on 0.12 micron technology (SFN-120).

SST25VF016B revisions B and C, based on SFN-120 (0.12 micron) process technology use the same mask set, are identical in form, fit, and function to our current SST25VF016B revision A devices that we have been shipping to customers in high volume, and is compatible in all respects with prior revisions. Revisions B and C will be nearing completion of SST's formal characterization and qualification process. Revision B and C samples are currently available.

We ask that our customers qualify both new revisions of the SST25VF016B in order to maintain operational flexibility. Again, these are identical products from two lines from the same fabrication facility.

Customers can visually identify the revision of the SST25VF016B by looking at the third row and last letter on the top of the device. For example, revision C product shows the letter "C" following a 7 digit number and a dash. For example: xxxxxxx-C, where x represents a number from 0 to 9.

This notification applies to all of the following part numbers.

SST25VF016B-50-4C-S2AF      SST25VF016B-50-4I-S2AF  
SST25VF016B-50-4C-QAF      SST25VF016B-50-4I-QAF

A 75MHz version of the SST25VF016B will also be released on our 0.12 micron process revisions B and C, (ex: "SST25VF016B-75-4C-S2AF"). Ultimately, we prefer all high volume customers migrate to the 75MHz device.
